

PARENTHOOD IN SWEDEN

Föräldraskap i Sverige består av sex träffar som ger dig som förälder information om sådant som är viktigt i Sverige, t.ex:

- föräldrars rättigheter och skyldigheter
- hur förskola, skola och vård fungerar
- hur kommunen kan hjälpa familjer
- fritidsaktiviteter i Älmhult
- hjälp som finns att få om man har problem med barnuppfostran i Sverige.

Being a parent in a different country than the one you grew up in can lead to questions about society and family life.

Parenthood in Sweden is for anyone who is a foreign born parent of one or more children aged 0–18 who would like to learn more about important things in Swedish society, such as:

- Parents' rights and obligations
- How preschool, school and healthcare work
- How the municipality can help families
- Leisure activities in Älmhult
- Support available in case one has problems with child raising in Sweden

In six sessions, you will get to meet other parents in the group and talk about different themes together with trained group leaders.
